VARIETY	DESCRIPTION	QUANTITY
CASABLANCA (FE) (O)	Chefs and cooks will love the versatility of this potato. Good for all uses from boiling and chipping to mash and roasting.	
COLLEEN (FE) (O)	A good all-rounder, high disease and pest resistance. Particularly good for baking and chips as well as being an excellent new potato.	
CHARLOTTE (SE) (O)	Charlotte is a French potato which can be stored up till Christmas. Noted for good resistance against slugs and common scab. They are ideal boiled as part of a salad as they hold their shape well and can even be roasted whole.	
MARIS PEER (SE) (O)	A medium-sized potato with good disease resistance which can be grown easily in a shady spot in the garden or container. In the kitchen it is good boiled or cooked as wedges.	
NICOLA (SE) (O)	Good yield, oval tubers with yellow skin and yellow flesh. It has a high resistance to common and powdery scab. Great for boiling and wedges.	
ALOUETTE (SE/EM) (O)	Alouette is a versatile red skinned table variety producing oval long tubers with shallow eyes and yellow flesh colour. It has excellent resistance to both foliage and tuber blight.	
AMBO (EM) (O)	A parti-coloured variety with good foliage and tuber late blight resistance. High yielding in a wide range of soil types and presents good drought resistance. Good blight and scab resistance. The plant produces floury potatoes which can be boiled or baked.	
ORLA (EM) (O)	Large white tubers of high blight and scab resistance which can be harvested early or left to bulk up. Versatile in the kitchen, can be used for most cooking methods – from baking and mashing to chips, boiling and roasting.	
SANTE (EM) (O)	Short oval tuber with cream skin, light yellow flesh, and shallow – medium eyes. They are a particularly good baking and boiling potato.	
SARPO UNA (SE) (O)	Multipurpose variety which can produce nice waxy salad potatoes if harvested early or can be left in ground for a heavy crop of baking potatoes. It has good resistance to late blight as well as a range of other diseases	

CARA (LM) (O)	Gardeners love Cara for its high levels of resistance to drought, blight, common scab and viruses. One of the best hardy growers, the tubers are white and round with shallow pink eyes. In the kitchen they are good for baking and chipping.	
CAROLUS (M) (O)	Carolus is a parti-coloured blight resistant variety with red flesh over a pale yellow skin. It has very high dry matter so is perfect for baking, mashing and roast potatoes.	
SARPO AXONA (M) (O)	One of the most popular Sarpo variety, produces high yields of big regular tubers with red skins. It has great blight and disease resistance.	
ARRAN VICTORY (LM) (O)	This Heritage variety is popular with growers due to high yields and long seasons. Distinct blue/purple skin covers white flesh, with a good earthy taste and make fantastic roasties and wonderful mash.	
RED DUKE OF YORK (FE)	Red skins and creamy white flesh tubers are produced from a fast growing plant. Used for colour in cooking when the skins are left on. It has a great flavour when mashed.	
EPIURE (FE)	High yielding floury, white fleshed tubers that are round in shape. By far one of the best tasting first earlies. Boil, mash or enjoy them with a salad.	
PENTLAND JAVELIN (FE)	Pentland Javelin produces heavy crops of short oval white-skinned tubers. A great potato to boil and use for salads. It has good all-round disease resistance. It can be left in the ground longer than most first earlies to mature further giving a more floury potato.	
HOME GUARD (FE)	Home Guard seed potatoes are well known for their early lifting ability. High-yielding and good resistance to scab. Home Guard is a superior potato of excellent flavour that does not go floury, making it excellent for boiling.	
KESTREL (SE)	Kestrel gives good yields of long oval, parti-coloured tubers which have good all-round cooking quality. It has good chipping potential, particularly early in the season. Also has excellent and disease and slug resistance.	
MARIS PIPER (EM)	Maris Piper has a golden skin and creamy white flesh with a fluffy texture. It has a high dry matter content making it a versatile all-rounder, great for chips and roast potatoes, but also good for mash and wedges.	
RATTE (EM)	Classic French variety which produces long shaped tubers with white skin and yellow flesh. It has a quite distinctive chestnut flavour and is delicious when boiled or steamed, hot or cold.	
KERR'S PINK (LM)	Round tubers with light pink skin and small delicate deep red eyes. The flesh is a cream-white with a very fine-grained, floury, fluffy texture once cooked. Recommended cooking with skin on and mashed, roasted, or baked.	
PINK FIR APPLE (LM)	Well known novelty variety with long and knobbly tubers. A firm white flesh surrounded by pink tinged skin. Waxy variety which brightens any salad.	
RED EMMALIE (EM)	Red skin and red flesh make this variety very attractive for chefs. It produces long oval tubers which have a smooth texture ideal for mashing and boiling.	
DESIREE (EM)	Desiree is a very popular red potato, with pale yellow and firm waxy flesh. It is good to boil, mash, chip or roast and has particularly good drought resistance.
