| <b>CASABLANCA<br/>(FE) (O) Smooth</b>       | Chefs and cooks will love the versatility of this potato. Good for all uses from boiling and chipping to mash and roasting.                                                                                                  |          |
| <b>COLLEEN<br/>(FE) (O) Waxy</b>            | A good all-rounder, early bulking variety with waxy flesh and medium dry matter, as well as high disease and pest resistance. Particularly good for baking and chips as well as being an excellent new potato.               |          |
| <b>FOREMOST<br/>(FE) Waxy</b>               | An old favourite, the short oval, cream-fleshed tuber has an excellent flavour and holds its shape when boiling. Like most heritage varieties, it will have average sized yields and disease resistance.                     |          |
| <b>LADY CHRISTL<br/>(FE) Waxy</b>           | Produces medium sized, yellow skinned, oval tubers, with good sized yields. Disease resistance is favourable. The flesh is creamy to waxy and is a good all-rounder for cooking.                                             |          |
| <b>PENTLAND<br/>JAVELIN<br/>(FE) Waxy</b>   | Produces heavy crops of short, oval, white-skinned tubers. Great for boiling and salads. Good all-round disease resistance. Can be left in the ground longer than most first earlies to mature giving a more floury potato.  |          |
| <b>RED DUKE OF<br/>YORK<br/>(FE) Smooth</b> | Red skins and creamy white flesh tubers are produced from a fast growing plant. Used for colour in cooking when the skins are left on. It has a great flavour when mashed with ample amounts of butter.                      |          |
| <b>CHARLOTTE<br/>(SE) (O) Waxy</b>          | A French potato which can be stored up till Christmas. Noted for good resistance against slugs and common scab. Ideal for boiling or roasting whole.                                                                         |          |
| <b>KESTREL<br/>(SE) Smooth</b>              | Kestrel gives good yields of long oval, parti-coloured tubers which have good all-round cooking quality. Also has excellent disease and slug resistance.                                                                     |          |
| <b>NICOLA<br/>(SE) Waxy</b>                 | Good yield, oval tubers with yellow skin and yellow flesh. It has a high resistance to common and powdery scab. Great for boiling and wedges.                                                                                |          |
| <b>RATTE<br/>(SE) Waxy</b>                  | Classic French variety producing long tubers with white skin and yellow flesh. Distinctive chestnut flavour, delicious when boiled or steamed, hot or cold.                                                                  |          |
| <b>SARPO UNA<br/>(SE) (O) Smooth</b>        | Multipurpose variety which can produce nice waxy salad potatoes if harvested early or can be left in ground for a heavy crop of baking potatoes. It has good resistance to late blight as well as a range of other diseases. |          |

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| <b>ALOUETTE<br/>(EM) (O) Smooth</b>                                  | Alouette is a versatile red skinned variety producing oval long tubers with shallow eyes and yellow flesh colour, good for baking, boiling, chipping and roasting. It also has excellent resistance to both foliage and tuber blight.                          |                                |
| <b>BLUE DANUBE<br/>(EM) Flourey</b>                                  | Unique blue skin, white flesh Sarpo variety with excellent overall disease resistance, ideal for roasting and chips. Because of its inbuilt dormancy it can be harvested in autumn then kept in a cool dark place until spring without sprouting or softening. |                                |
| <b>ORLA<br/>(EM) (O) Smooth</b>                                      | Large white tubers with high blight and scab resistance. Can be harvested early or left to bulk up. Good for baking, mashing, chips, boiling and roasting.                                                                                                     |                                |
| <b>ARRAN VICTORY<br/>(MC) (O) Flourey</b>                            | Popular heritage variety due to high yields and long seasons. Distinct blue/purple skin covers white flesh with a good earthy taste which does fall apart when boiling but does make a great mash and fantastic roasties.                                      |                                |
| <b>CARA<br/>(MC) (O) Flourey</b>                                     | Cara has high levels of resistance to drought, blight, common scab and viruses. The tubers are white and round with shallow pink eyes. Good for baking and chips.                                                                                              |                                |
| <b>DESIREE<br/>(MC) Smooth</b>                                       | Desiree is a very popular red potato, with pale yellow and firm waxy flesh. Reasonable resistance to viruses and blight. It is good to bake, boil, mash, chip or roast and has particularly good drought resistance.                                           |                                |
| <b>GOLDEN WONDER<br/>(MC) (O) Flourey</b>                            | Brown rough skinned tuber with a very high dry matter, ideal for chipping. This potato benefits from the best flavour developing a few months after lifting. Making it ideal for the small grower who wishes to harvest and enjoy the rewards gradually.       |                                |
| <b>JAVA<br/>(MC) (O) Smooth</b>                                      | Java is a consistently high-yielding variety with attractive long red tubers and excellent fungal, bacterial, virus and pest resistance. Particularly good for chips.                                                                                          |                                |
| <b>KERR'S PINK<br/>(MC) Flourey</b>                                  | Round tubers with light pink skin and small deep red eyes and a cream-white flesh. Recommended cooking with skin on and mashed, roasted, or baked.                                                                                                             |                                |
| <b>KING EDWARD<br/>(MC) Flourey</b>                                  | King Edward is one of the oldest UK potato varieties, Favoured for its excellent taste, good keeping properties and above average disease resistance. Medium dry matter, good for crisps, wedges, baking, boiling, chips, roast and mash.                      |                                |
| <b>MARIS PIPER<br/>(MC) Flourey</b>                                  | Golden skin, creamy white flesh and a fluffy texture. It has a high dry matter content making it great for chips, roast potatoes, mash and wedges.                                                                                                             |                                |
| <b>SARPO AXONA<br/>(MC) (O) Flourey</b>                              | Produces high yields of big tubers with red skins. It has great blight and disease resistance coupled with its weed smothering foliage and natural dormancy makes it ideal for the enthusiast or beginner. Good for baking, chips, roast, mash and chips.      |                                |
| <b>SUNSET<br/>(MC) (O) Waxy</b>                                      | A recommended alternative to Desiree. Sunset produces long oval tubers with deep red skin and creamy flesh. Really high yields. Perfect for mashing, boiling and roasting.                                                                                     |                                |
